These courses require Activity fees as outlined and are taught in Japanese. You will be notified on Monday, April 8 via CAMPUS WEB regarding the pre-registration results. Once your placement is confirmed, you will not be able to cancel these courses.  
 Note: Should the number of students who pre-register for JTA Courses exceed the maximum number of students allowed to enroll, the final class selection will be determined by a lottery.
