2. 実習料

Japanese Traditional Arts Courses are optional. You may pre-register for as many of the Japanese Traditional Arts courses as you like, or none at all. These courses require Activity fees as outlined and are taught in Japanese.

You will be notified on Monday, April 8 via CAMPUS WEB regarding the pre-registration results. Once your placement is confirmed, you will not be able to cancel these courses.

Note: Should the number of students who pre-register for JTA Courses exceed the maximum number of students allowed to enroll, the final class selection will be determined by a lottery.
