



# **Business-Level Japanese**

is required by the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> year (Undergraduates) or 1<sup>st</sup> year(Graduates) if you want to work in Japan.

You should start learning Business Japanese <u>from today</u>.

Most Japanese companies hire international students who can make business with local Japanese.

# 2. Job Hunting in Japan

### What Business-level Japanese is

- · (Reading) Able to read business Japanese correctly
- · (Writing) Able to write Japanese without grammatical mistakes
- (Listening) Able to understand spoken Japanese at natural speed
- · (Speaking) Able to speak Japanese at the same speed as Japanese



# Required native Japanese level.

If you are...

- > able to understand when it's not too fast.
- > still at a conversation level.
- ⇒ You'd better improve your Japanese.


