

## International Dormitory Q&A (for students who will enroll at Kinugasa Campus)

 <b>How many students does a room accommodate?</b>	 All student rooms are single-occupancy. Bathrooms and shower rooms are shared.
 <b>Can I enter the international dormitory in the middle of a semester?</b>	 You cannot enter the dormitory in the middle of a semester. If you wish to enter the dormitory, please follow the procedures found in the guidebook that will be sent to you before you enter the university.
 <b>Is there a cafeteria in the dormitory?</b>	 No, there is no cafeteria. However, you can prepare meals using the shared kitchen.
 <b>How much is the dormitory fee?</b>	 The fee for the international dormitory has not been determined yet. However, it should be less than ¥50,000 per month.
 <b>Is Internet access available?</b>	 Wi-Fi is available. The usage fee is included in the dormitory fee.
 <b>How long does it take to get to campus?</b>	 It takes about 15 minutes to walk to Kinugasa Campus.
 <b>Are there any grocery stores near the dormitory?</b>	 There are some restaurants and supermarkets nearby. You will have no problem shopping for daily essentials.
 <b>Is there a dormitory at Ritsumeikan University? Am I eligible to live there?</b>	 Yes, there is a dormitory at KIC (Kinugasa Campus) for international students who will be studying there. Students who reside outside Japan at the time of application will have priority in securing rooms.
 <b>Can Ritsumeikan University provide information on share rooms?</b>	 No, we do not have any information about individual apartments or share rooms. Please ask the real estate agencies near campus.
 <b>Do you have any information about homestays?</b>	 No, we do not have any information about homestays.
