Both Japanese and international students live together with 6 people to 1 unit, fostering intercultural understanding and communication competence by sharing common areas. Each unit also includes a RM (Resident Mentor) to help support dormitory life.

What is an RM (Resident Mentor)?


An RM (Resident Mentor) is a fellow dormitory resident who is available to help with any problems or difficulties related to living in the dorm, university life, or living in Japan. RMs also plan regular exchange events for dormitory residents. One RM lives in each unit.




