

OIC I-House Moving Out Survey Results

- 94% were satisfied with dormitory life as a whole.
- Over half of residents had concerns about living with other people before moving in, but when they moved out, over 70% of residents said that living in the dormitory was better than they had expected.
- When asked about reasons they were glad they moved into the dormitory, 94% of residents answered "I can interact/make friends with students from many different countries" and 65% answered "There are RMs who offer consultation and support".
- 76% of residents felt that they had changed/grown as a result of living in the dormitory.

Students who took advantage of the dormitory's international environment, support from RMs, and events and who actively reached out to others and put effort into getting along had better experiences overall.
