Chest X-ray Exam Schedule for International Students at BKC

Chest X-rays are part of the regular annual health examinations conducted on-campus for our university students. Please understand, however, that chest X-rays will be administered only for students who have been in Japan for over 14 days.

Possible Spring Semester 2020 Exam Dates

Option 1: (Thu) April 2

For students who entered Japan on or before March 18, 2020.

Option 2: (Thu) April 9

For students who entered Japan on or before March 25, 2020.

Other back-up dates will be arranged at a later time for students unable to attend either of the exam dates above. Once those dates are determined, information will be posted to the homepage at the link below. Be sure to check it regularly for updates.

【Contents of Medical Check】

Chest X-ray *All students

The following items will not be implemented in medical examination to prevent the spread of COVID-19 infection.

Height and Weight ・ Blood Pressure ・ Urinalysis

★★★To avoid congestion, we distribute an admission ticket of the day at Medical Service Center. Please enter the venue at time listed in an entrance ticket. Thank you for your cooperation.

Those who meet any of the following conditions, cannot have an medical examination.

1. Had been abroad for the past two weeks (before April 2nd or April 9th).
2. Had cold-like symptoms such as fever or cough for the past two weeks (before April 2nd or April 9th).
3. Have a fever on the day ($\geq 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$).
4. Pregnant or possibly pregnant .
