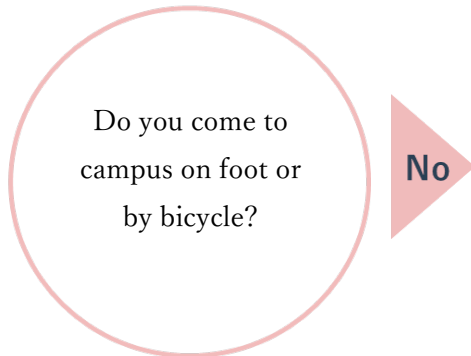


How to Utilize Fever Clinics For Those Studying and Working at RU

STEP. 1

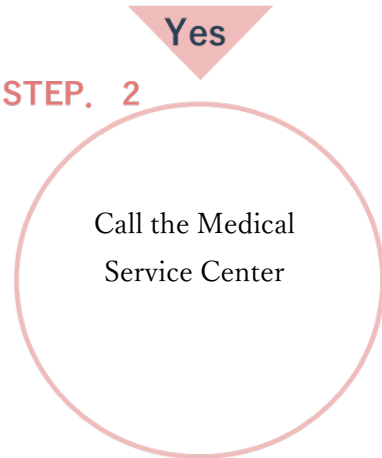


If you cannot come to the campus without using public transportation (i.e., train or bus):

⇒Please call your local medical institution.

*Those who cannot come to the campus without using public transportation will not be able to receive a medical examination. If there is no medical institution with which you can consult, please call the Medical Service Center.

STEP. 2



Those who can come on foot or by bicycle without using public transportation will be able to receive a medical examination.

⇒Please call the Medical Service Center on your campus first.

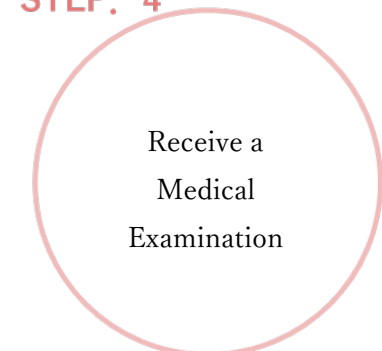
