3. Note

$\star\star$ If you have had serious side effects in the past, you cannot take vaccination on campus.

- (1) Please wear a mask and use hand alcohol disinfection. Please cooperate with us as the temperature will be measured at the reception.
- (2) If you meet the following conditions, you will not be able to receive a vaccination.
 - 1. Do you have symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, general fatigue, sore throat, runny nose or nasal congestion, headache, joint / muscle pain, diarrhea, nausea or vomiting (so-called cold symptoms)?
 - 2. Do you take antipyretics (fever medications)?
 - 3. Do you feel any abnormalities in your ability to taste or smell?
 - 4. Did you have a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher in the past 2 weeks?
 - 5. Have you experienced any gastrointestinal symptoms such as diarrhea that lasted 4-5 days without any underlying known cause?
 - 6. Did you travel to other countries in the past 2 weeks? (Or have you been in close contact with anyone in your family or at your workplace who has travelled to other countries in the past 2 weeks?)
 - 7. In the past 2 weeks, have you been in close contact with a known or possible COVID-19 case (including someone whom you live with or at your workplace who suffering from a fever)?
 - 8. Are you under quarantine (including self-quarantine) because of the possibility of close contact with a COVID-19 patient?
- (3) Please avoid receiving vaccination at campus if you had severe side effects before.
- (4) Please note that even if you wish to receive the flu vaccine, it may not be possible due to your health status and/or availability of the vaccine.
- (5) Please remain 30 minutes after the vaccination on campus for observation, as there may be an acute adverse reaction.
- Bring your student ID card, a ball pen, and cash on the day. Please pay us the correct price by cash. If you do not show your student's ID card, you cannot get the support.
- (7) Please have someone as a translator if you do not speak Japanese.
- (8) The vaccine for Influenza (flu) and COVID-19 need to be at least 2 weeks apart.
