He is author of Japan's Relations with North Korea and the Recalibration of Risk and co-author of Regional Risk and Security in Japan and Risk State, as well as writing and researching on Okinawa for the Asahi Shimbun, The Conversation UK and The Asan Forum. In 2014 he was awarded a JSPS Fellowship to research nationalism in Okinawa at the University of the Ryukyus.
