

For those who substitute their new employee, pre-travel, or post-travel medical examination, or complete medical checkup "Ningen Dock" results for the annual medical examination

1. What kind of medical examination can I substitute?

You can substitute the results of those examinations taking **after April 1 2024** for the annual medical examination results.

2. Can I take a medical examination on campus?

Yes you can. Some medical checkup items are different from the medical examination for new employee, pre-travel, or post-travel. Items not included in the medical examination for new employee, pre-travel, or post-travel include (1) colon cancer screening, (2) ABCD screening, and (3) prostate cancer screening (etc.). Please note that if you were eligible for ABCD screening in the year of substitution, you will be eligible for the next five-year milestone age. For details, please refer to the on-campus medical examination guide.

3. What do I need to do in order to substitute?

No application is required. If you do not need an information envelope for the medical examination on campus, we will send you an email around the end of August with instructions on how to apply.

4. Can I take the examination off campus and receive vaccination against influenza on campus?

Yes, you can. Please fill in the questionnaire for influenza vaccine ([yoshinhyo](#)) that you can download from here and come to the medical examination venue for those from Suzaku Campus or to the On-Campus Medical Service Center for those from Kinugasa or OIC. Influenza vaccination will not be given at the time of medical examination at BKC. A separate flu vaccination opportunity will be offered on the afternoon of 11/1, 5, and 6 at the Medical Service Center. Details will be emailed as soon as they are finalized. The on-campus vaccination fee is 2,000 yen. (The fee may change.)

5. Can I receive breast cancer screening along with the annual medical examination?

The off-campus medical institutions offer the annual medical examination only.

The University will offer breast cancer screening on each campus in fall. Ultrasound will be used for the screening in AY2024. If you wish to undergo the screening, you will be required to make an online appointment in the same way as you did for the annual medical examination in the past academic years. * If you are unable to take the examination during this period, the University advises faculty and staff members to use breast cancer screening conducted by municipalities or a cancer screening subsidy program offered by the Ritsumeikan Trust.
