Asymmetric conflicts are often considered among the most challenging types of conflicts to resolve. This presentation explores the complexities of analyzing asymmetric conflicts—situations characterized by a significant disparity in power, status, and strategy between parties, including conflicts between state and non-state actors. It highlights the key methods and approaches used to understand and assess these conflicts, with a particular focus on the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, while also drawing insights from other conflict resolution and peacebuilding efforts. Furthermore, the complexity of assessing the impact of conflict, and the role of third-party mediation will be discussed, as well as the benefits and challenges associated with examining asymmetric conflicts through an interdisciplinary approach.
