

International Research Seminar: "Changes on the Korean Peninsula and Japan-South Korea Cooperation"

On Monday, November 11, 2024, the Center for East Asian Peace and Cooperation Studies at Ritsumeikan University hosted an international research seminar titled "Changes on the Korean Peninsula and Japan-South Korea Cooperation."

The seminar focused on the potential shifts in the Korean Peninsula's dynamics following the recent U.S. presidential election results. Discussions centered on how Japan and South Korea could work together to address these changes effectively. The event featured participation from former foreign ministers, vice ministers, ambassadors, and current Japanese government officials, providing a rare opportunity for realistic and precise insights into diplomatic and practical collaboration. The seminar underscored the critical role of Japan-South Korea cooperation in navigating the volatile landscape of the Korean Peninsula influenced by global political developments.
