Precarious Cycle of Migrant Workers' Reproductive Justice: The Case of Indonesian Migrant Workers in Japan

The sexual and reproductive rights of female migrant laborers are influenced by both their home and destination countries. In Southeast Asia, practices like mandatory pregnancy testing and restrictions on reproductive rights are prevalent. Also, despite constitutional protections against discrimination for pregnant workers in Japan, many still face violations. This study examines the reproductive rights experiences of Indonesian migrant workers in Japan.
