Application for the Kawata Heihachiro Scholarship

Our school has established the “Kawata Heihachiro Scholarship” to support students who possess outstanding qualities and talents and aspire to contribute to the school and society.

Applicants taking the Domestic Entrance Examinations (“Recommendation A” or “Recommendation B”), or the International Entrance Examinations (“International Recommendation November / February Admission”, are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Those wishing to apply should follow the guidelines below.

※Heihachiro Kawata was the founder and first principal of Uji Gakuen, the predecessor of our school. The Heihachiro Kawata Scholarship is funded by his donation.

(1) Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- ① Be a student with excellent sports records who will be applying for recommendation or who will be entering the school internally has excellent character, and has high aspirations to contribute to the school and society through sports activities.
- ② Be a student with excellent results in academic, artistic, or cultural activities who will be applying for recommendation or who will be entering the school internally, and who has excellent character, and has high aspirations to contribute to the school and society through their academic, artistic, or cultural activities.
- ③ Be a student with high motivation and abilities for international exchange who will be applying for recommendation or who will be entering the school internally, and who has excellent character, and has high aspirations to contribute to the school and society through international exchange.

※ The scholarship may be combined with other grants or scholarships from the school.

(2) Criteria

Selection will be based on a comprehensive evaluation of the following four areas.

- ❶ The qualities and talents the applicant possesses, and the activities he or she has engaged in in the past.
- ❷ The ways and methods by which the applicant intends to contribute to the school and society after enrollment.
- ❸ The feasibility of ❷.
- ❹ The impact on the school and society of ❷.

(3) Grant amount: 300,000 yen as a one-time payment in April of the first year of high school.

(4) Number of recipients: 10 students in total

(Selected from applicants for the Domestic Entrance Examinations “Recommendation A” and “Recommendation B,” the International Entrance Examinations “International Recommendation (November Admission / February Admission),” and students planning to advance internally from Ritsumeikan Uji Junior High School.)

(5) Application Procedure

- ① Applications for scholarships are accepted through the online application tool, Google Forms. You may use an existing Google account to submit your application or create a new one if needed. If you wish to create a new account, please click “Create account” on the following site:

- * Please scan the document at the highest possible resolution and check that it is clear and legible before submitting.
- * Please name the file using your full name followed by the phonetic reading in parentheses (e.g. 立命 太郎 (リツメイ タロウ)).
