Our school began operating a new student dormitory (Ritsumeikan Uji Dormitory) on campus in April 2026. The dormitory has a capacity of 52 students per grade level, for a total of 156 students. For the 2026 academic year, **we are unable to accept students transferring into the High School 2nd Year IG Course because the dormitory's capacity for 2nd-year students has already been reached.** Even if you are accepted, you will not be able to live in the dormitory. From the perspective of ensuring student safety and managing daily life, **a condition of admission is that you must commute to school while living with a parent or an adult relative equivalent to a parent. If you cannot meet this condition, you will be required to decline admission.**

We ask that applicants from out of town consider their commuting arrangements at the earliest stage when applying, such as securing a **guardian or an adult relative equivalent to a guardian** with whom they can live.

Please take the above points into consideration when deciding whether to apply.
