(The English translation is below the Japanese.)

(趣旨)

第1条 この学部則は、<u>立命館大学学則第45条</u>にもとづき、グローバル教養学部の授業科目、卒業に必要な単位 数、単位認定その他の教育課程に関する事項について定める。

(デュアル・ディグリー)

第2条 グローバル教養学部においては、グローバル教養学部の在学中にオーストラリア国立大学に入学し、またはオーストラリア国立大学の在学中にグローバル教養学部に入学し、双方の大学により定められた所定の単位数を修得することにより、本大学およびオーストラリア国立大学の双方の学位を取得すること(以下「デュアル・ディグリー」という。)ができる。

(英文表記)

第3条 グローバル教養学部の英文表記はCollege of Global Liberal Artsとし、グローバル教養学科の英文表記はDepartment of Global Liberal Artsとする。

(教育研究上の目的)

第4条 グローバル教養学部は、人文学および社会諸科学の教育研究、また日本およびオーストラリアを含むアジアの諸社会における様々なボーダーを超える経験と主体的な学びを通じて、人間社会の多様性への洞察と人類史をグローバルに俯瞰する視点を具え、高い倫理観のもとに、新しい科学・技術の発展を踏まえた未来社会への革新的な構想力と豊かな表現力をもって、グローバル化する社会のなかで実践的に問題発見・問題解決をリードし、そのために学び続けることのできる人間を育成することを目的とする。

(教育課程の編成)

第5条 グローバル教養学部の授業科目は、Foundation Courses、Introductory Courses、Special Lectures、Intermediate Courses、Advanced Courses、Japanese Language CoursesおよびOthersに区分し、これを4年間に配当して編成する。

(授業科目)

- 第6条 グローバル教養学部の授業科目の名称、単位数、授業方法、必修科目・選択科目・自由科目の別および配当年次は、<u>次の各号</u>に掲げる区分ごとに<u>当該各号</u>に定める<u>別表</u>のとおりとする。
 - (1) Foundation Courses <u>別表1</u>
 - (2) Introductory Courses <u>別表2</u>
 - (3) Special Lectures <u>別表3</u>
 - (4) Intermediate Courses 別表4
 - (5) Advanced Courses <u>別表5</u>
 - (6) Japanese Language Courses <u>別表6</u>
 - (7) Others 別表7
- 2 <u>前項</u>に定める授業科目のうち、多様なメディアを高度に利用して行う遠隔授業科目は、<u>別表8</u>のとおりとする。 (履修科目の登録の上限)
- 第7条 学生が1学期に履修科目として登録することができる単位数の上限は、21単位とする。ただし、<u>次の各号</u>に 掲げる授業科目は、単位数の上限を超えて登録することができる。
 - (1) 別表に定める必修科目・選択科目・自由科目の別を自由とする授業科目
 - (2) Internship 1、Internship 2およびInternship 3
 - (3) 前各号のほか、グローバル教養学部教授会が承認した授業科目

(卒業に必要な単位数)

- 第8条 卒業に必要な単位数は、<u>別表</u>に定める必修科目・選択科目・自由科目の別を必修とする授業科目を含み、かつ、<u>次の各号</u>に掲げる単位数を含む124単位以上とする。ただし、自由科目の単位を含めることはできない。
 - (1) Foundation Courses 12単位以上
 - (2) Introductory Courses 8単位以上
 - (3) Intermediate Courses 6単位以上
 - (4) Advanced Courses 4単位以上。ただし、Research Seminarを4単位以上を含む。
 - (カリキュラム適用)
- 第8条の2 授業科目の種類および単位数、履修方法、卒業に必要な単位数ならびに単位認定等(以下「カリキュラム」という。)については、入学時に適用したカリキュラムを卒業まで適用する。

 - (2) 本大学およびオーストラリア国立大学のデュアル・ディグリーに関わる協定に定められたオーストラリア国立大学の英語の語学力に係る入学基準に達していること。
- 2 オーストラリア国立大学において1年次の履修を開始した者でデュアル・ディグリーを希望するものは、オーストラリア国立大学が定める授業科目のうち1年間に相当する履修を終えた学期末において、累積のGPAがオーストラリア国立大学において定めた基準で4.0以上でなければならない。 (改廃)
- 第10条 この学部則の改廃は、グローバル教養学部教授会の議を経て、大学協議会で行う。

College of Global Liberal Arts Academic Regulations [Translated Version]

Objective

I. Based on Article 45 of the Ritsumeikan University Regulations (hereinafter, "University Regulations"), these academic regulations shall provide for matters related to the curricular subjects, credits required for graduation, approval of credits, and curriculum in the College of Global Liberal Arts.

Dual Degree

II. In the College of Global Liberal Arts, students enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts are admitted to the Australian National University (hereinafter, "ANU"), and students enrolled at ANU are admitted to the College of Global Liberal Arts, allowing students to graduate with two degrees from both Ritsumeikan University and ANU through a program that enables them to acquire the prescribed number of credits respectively designated by both universities (hereinafter, "Dual Degree Program").

Official English Notation

III. The official English notation of the College of Global Liberal Arts shall be written as "College of Global Liberal Arts" and the official English notation of the Department of Global Liberal Arts shall be written as "Department of Global Liberal Arts".

Education and Research Objectives

IV. The aim of the College of Global Liberal Arts is to train people who can identify the problems in our increasingly global society in a practical way, take a lead in the solution of those problems and be able to persevere in their studies in order to achieve this. These people will possess an insight into the diversity of human society and a global perspective of human history, they will act based on a keen sense of ethics and will have ample verbalization and visualization skills and an innovative imagination regarding a future that is based on the advances of science and technology. This will be achieved through education and research in the humanities and social sciences and through experiences and independent learning that cross numerous borders in Japan, Australia and

the various other societies of Asia.

Organization of Curriculum

V. College of Global Liberal Arts curricular subjects are divided into Foundation Courses, Introductory Courses, Special Lectures, Intermediate Courses, Advanced Courses, Japanese Language Courses, and Others and apportioned over a span of 4 years.

Curricular Subjects

- VI. The names, number of credits, class methods, classification as either mandatory, elective or optional, and student year levels of curricular subjects available in the College of Global Liberal Arts shall be prescribed in the specified Appendix for each of the following subject groups.
 - (1) Foundation Courses Appendix 1
 - (2) Introductory Courses Appendix 2
 - (3) Special Lectures Appendix 3
 - (4) Intermediate Courses Appendix 4
 - (5) Advanced Courses Appendix 5
 - (6) Japanese Language Courses Appendix 6
 - (7) Others Appendix 7
- 2. Media-based classes are prescribed in the Appendix 8.

Course Registration Limits

- VII. The maximum number of credits that a student may register in one semester is 21 credits.

 However, the following curricular subjects are not subject to the aforementioned credit limitation.
 - (1) Courses that are designated as optional in the Appendices
 - (2) Internship 1, Internship 2 and Internship 3
 - (3) Courses other than those above that have been approved by the Faculty Council of the College of Global Liberal Arts

Credits Required for Graduation

VIII. The number of credits required for graduation, which must include the courses designated as mandatory in the Appendices and the number of credits in each of the following subject groups,

shall be 124 credits or more. However, courses that are designated as optional in the Appendices cannot be included in the number of credits required for graduation.

- (1) Foundation Courses At least 12 credits
- (2) Introductory Courses At least 8 credits
- (3) Intermediate Courses At least 6 credits
- (4) Advanced Courses At least 4 credits, fulfilled with 4 credits of "Research Seminar"
- 2 Types of courses, credits, methods of taking classes, credits required for graduation, and credit transfer (aggregately referred to as "curriculum") apply to the curriculum assigned at time of admission until graduation.
- 2-2 Students shall be assigned to the same curriculum applied to their same admission year in which they will transfer or be readmitted.
- 2-3 Students shall be assigned to the same curriculum applied to their same admission year of the registry status or department to which you will transfer.

Taking Courses for Dual Degree Program

- IX. Students who started their first year in the College of Global Liberal Arts and who wish to participate in the Dual Degree Program must satisfy all the following requirements at the end of the semester in which they have undertaken courses and receive grades for a total of 32 RU credits from the curricular subjects prescribed in the Appendices.
- (1) Possess a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or higher according to the standards set by ANU.
- (2) Possess the English language proficiency level required for admission to ANU as prescribed in the agreement concerning the Ritsumeikan University and ANU Dual Degree Program.
- 2. Students who have started their first year at ANU and who wish to participate in the Dual Degree Program must possess a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or higher according to the standards of ANU at the end of the semester in which they complete one year full time load equivalent study in the curricular subjects prescribed by ANU.

Amendment and Abolition

X. Amendment or abolition of these academic regulations shall be determined by the University Council following deliberation by the Faculty Council of the College of Global Liberal Arts.

Supplementary Provisions

These academic regulations are effective as of April 1, 2019.

Supplementary provision (January 25, 2019: Partial amendments following changes to Year Level) These academic regulations are effective as of April 1, 2019.

Supplementary Provision (March 29, 2019: Partial amendments following changes to requirements for the dual degree)

These academic regulations are effective as of April 1, 2019.

Supplementary Provisions (January 31, 2020: Partial amendments following changes to university-wide reform on study abroad programs and requirements for the dual degree)

- 1. These academic regulations are effective as of April 1, 2020.
- 2. Notwithstanding the preceding clause, the provisions then in force shall remain applicable to students enrolled in the program as of March 31, 2020.
- Notwithstanding the preceding clause, the revised provisions of Articles IX shall apply to students admitted in and after April 1, 2019 and enrolled in the program as of March 31, 2020.

Supplementary Provisions (February 18, 2022: Partial amendments following changes to Capstone Studies courses)

1. This academic regulations are effective as of April 1, 2022.

Supplementary Provisions (March 10, 2023: Partial amendments following changes to Organization of Curriculum, Course Registration Limits, Credits Required for Graduation and the addition and deletion of courses including media-based courses)

- 1. This academic regulations are effective as of April 1, 2023.
- 2. Notwithstanding the preceding clause, the provisions then in force shall remain applicable to students enrolled in the program as of March 31 2023.
- 3. Notwithstanding the preceding clause, changes to Clause 7 shall be applicable to students enrolled in the program as of March 31 2023.
- 4. Notwithstanding the preceding clause 2, elective courses in Appendix 1 7 shall be applicable to students enrolled in the program as of March 31 2023. In this case, Curricular Subjects, Credits, Class Style and Year Level shall be as prescribed respectively in the following clauses.

Supplementary Provisions (January 12, 2024: Partial amendments following changes to Article of "Curriculum Applicability")

- 1. This academic regulations are effective as of April 1, 2024.
- 2. Notwithstanding the preceding clause, the provisions then in force shall remain applicable to students enrolled in the program as of March 31 2024.
- 3. Notwithstanding the preceding clause, the Article VIII-2 shall remain applicable to students admitted in the program on and after April 1, 2019.
- 4. Notwithstanding the preceding clause 2, the change to credits in Article VI-1, Appendix 4 shall be applied to students admitted in the program on and after April 1, 2023.
