

Travel Clinic Consultation Patterns April 2018

Pattern (1) E.g. Studying in the United States – When submission of certificates for specific vaccinations are requested by the university. In the case that 2 doses each for measles, rubella, mumps, and chickenpox; 3 doses for hepatitis B, and a Tdap are required.

- The 3rd dose of Hepatitis B is 5 months after the 2nd Dose. Receive the vaccination at your travel destination or after returning to Japan.
- The Tdap vaccine is not approved in Japan. Receive the vaccine at a clinic which imports the vaccine by themselves.

Pattern (2) E.g. Studying in Southeast Asia – When no vaccinations are designated by the university. In the case that 2 doses for measles, rubella, mumps, and chickenpox, 3 doses for hepatitis A, and additional doses for tetanus and Japanese encephalitis are considered desirable.

Pattern (3) E.g. Studying in Europe – When no vaccinations are designated by the university. In the case that 2 doses for measles and rubella are considered desirable.
