Liberal Arts Courses Group B : "Liberal Arts Seminar"

<Course Outline>

This course is a small group class in which students research, discuss, and make presentations in the context of their interests and majors, triggered by the area of expertise of each instructor in charge. These activities are conducted in target languages other than Japanese. Students not only deepen their knowledge, but also learn a lot from the interaction among students with diverse backgrounds.

<Attainment Objectives>

- To be able to go beyond one's own field or specialty, to understand things, from a multifaceted perspective, in a language other than Japanese, and to be able to use that language to communicate with confidence.
- To experience independent learning in a language other than Japanese, and to learn how to learn independently.

<Important Notes>

Each course specifies the expected range of the language proficiency of course participants. Please confirm the level of the language before registering. Students whose language proficiency is above the specified range are welcome to register, although please be aware that the instructor may need to adjust the level of instruction to students who are within the target level.

The "Teaching Language" will be the primary language used by the instructor in class. However, Japanese will also be used to help facilitate learning when needed.

Once your placement is confirmed, you will not be able to cancel these courses.

1. 科目概要

- ・授業は原則対面で行われますが、一部オンライン対応が可能な授業があります。
- ・対面でのみ行われる授業については、入国状況によっては、授業が10月中下旬から開始する場合があります。詳細は授業開始前にご連絡します。
- ・もし入国状況により、希望科目の受講ができない場合は、大学にて受講登録を削除いたします。受講できない場合も想定し、受講登録は余裕をもって行ってください。
- ・選択科目です。希望する科目を、複数事前登録することができます。
- ・授業は、講義と実習で構成されています。詳細はシラバスを確認してください。
- ・授業は日本語で行われます。別途実習料が必要です。
- ・Off-campusの科目については、実習地までバスで移動する必要があります。移動時間が余裕をもって確保できる場合のみ、受講希望の申請を行ってください。また第1回目の授業にはスタッフが引率します。集合場所等の詳細は、メールでお知らせします。
- ・移動時間を余裕をもって確保できる場合のみ、他キャンパスの科目を受講することも可能です。ただし、抽選となった場合は所属キャンパスの学生が優先されます。
- ・授業スケジュールに変更がある場合は、メールや授業内でお知らせします。

1. Course Outline

- ・ Japanese Traditional Arts courses (JTA) are generally offered face-to-face, but some courses may be available online.
- ・ Courses offered face-to-face may start in the middle or end of October, depending on immigration status. Details will be provided prior to the start of classes.
- ・ If you are unable to take JTA courses due to the entry ban, the university will delete your course registration. Please register well in advance in case you cannot take these course.

- ・ The JTA courses are elective courses. You may pre-register for as many of the JTA courses as you like, or none at all.
- ・ Courses consist of both lecture classes and hands-on practice. Please check the online syllabus for details.
- ・ They are taught in Japanese and have a required additional activity fee.
- ・ For courses held off-campus, students will be required to get to the class location by bus. If you wish to apply for these courses, please ensure that you will have enough time to travel to the class.

Also, for the first class, an SKP staff member will accompany the students to the class location. Details of the initial meeting place will be sent by email.

- ・ You may take courses at other campuses only if you can have enough time to travel. Please note that priority will be given to students from the campus where the course is offered in the event of selection by lottery.

・ If there are any changes to the course schedule, you will be notified via email or in class.
