
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About the IB Course

In the IB Course, students take pre-IB classes in the first year and earn the credits necessary to graduate from a high school in Japan. In the second and third years, they take the International Baccalaureate (IB) classes required for obtaining the International Baccalaureate Diploma. Study abroad is not included in this program.

About Personal Information

I. Entrance Examinations in November 2022 and February 2023

1. Application Qualifications

An applicant must be 15 years old or older as of April 1, 2023 and have completed a nine-year curriculum* at an educational institution or institutions, whether inside or outside Japan (including international schools either inside or outside Japan), or be expected to complete such a program by June 2023.

* The “nine-year curriculum” is equivalent to the compulsory education curriculum in Japan.

If an applicant has completed a nine-year curriculum at an institution outside Japan, but is younger than 15 years old as of April 1, 2023, please consult the school individually.

* If an applicant will complete a nine-year curriculum by June 2023, the month of entrance will be September 2023. (If an applicant has Japanese nationality, please consult the school individually.)

3. Examination Categories and Requirements

Recommendation	An applicant whose first choice is Ritsumeikan Uji, who has excellent academic performance and character, who satisfies the criteria of our recommendation system, and who has received a recommendation from the principal of his or her junior high school.
Single application	An applicant whose first choice is Ritsumeikan Uji and who can guarantee matriculation at the school upon a successful result in the entrance examination.

4. Procedure for Designation of Recommendation Category

(1) Qualifications of Recommendation

An applicant who wishes to take the examination in the “Recommendation category” as described on page 1 (2. Outline of the Entrance Examinations) must receive our approval prior to applying to take the examination in November or February (not including the transfer examination).

(2) Application Procedure for Designation of Recommendation

- ① Download the international recommendation application form from our website.
- ② Send the following three documents to Ritsumeikan Uji within the prescribed period (listed below).
 - ① International recommendation application form
 - ② A copy of academic transcripts for each of the last three years
 - ③ Copy of the results of an examination of English proficiency

 For the examination in February November 21 (Mon.) to December 19 (Mon.), 2022

* The application documents must arrive no later than the dates listed above.

- ③ After being selected for the “Recommendation category”, applicants can apply to take the entrance examination in the “Recommendation category”.

* Applicants cannot apply for the Incentive Scholarship if they don't receive Recommendation category status in advance.

5. Method of Selection

(1) English Essay

English Essay is divided into a novel reading comprehension and a composing essay. The word count of composing essay for each testing system is as follows.

Testing System	Word count of the essay
Online IB	between 300 and 500 words.
IB	between 550 and 800 words.

(2) Mathematics Examination

Given in English only. The applicant must answer in English.

(3) Interview

The applicant will sit a two-part interview. In the first part, the applicant will be interviewed

individually; in the second part, the applicant will be interviewed together with his/her parent or guardian. The interview will be conducted primarily English.

(4) Language of Parent or Guardian Interview

The interview is primarily conducted in English or Japanese. If the parent or guardian cannot communicate in English or Japanese during the interview, please fill in parent language section on the Personal Information Form.

We may be able to offer interpreting; however, if the parent/guardian prefers a language other than English or Japanese, the examination venue has to be at Ritsumeikan Uji. Please understand that we cannot guarantee interpreting in all cases. (Note: The parent or guardian’s language will not affect the examination result.)

6. Application Procedures

(1) How to apply

- ① Register necessary information on the application web system posted on the school website.
- ② Remit the examination fee through the application web system. (only valid Credit Cards can be used.)
- ③ After completion of remittance, the Application Form and Examination Admission Card can be output from website.
- ④ Prepare other necessary documents, then send the all documents to Ritsumeikan Uji.

8. Precautions for the Examination

※ The following are precautions to be taken at the school venue. Precautions for the Online Examination will be announced after receipt of applications.

(1) What to bring on the examination day

- ① Examination card
- ② HB black pencils or mechanical pencils, erasers.
 - *Wristwatch are allowed to be used, but watches with calculator function are not allowed.
 - *Cellphone use is prohibited. If you bring it, switch off it and keep it inside your bag.
 - *The following are not permitted to be used; underlays, rulers, calculators, dictionaries, earplugs.
- ③ Indoor shoes and bags to keep outdoor shoes contained. (We change shoes at our school, so all examinees will need to bring shoes that they only use indoors.)

(2) Precautions for the examination

- ① Please enter the room by 8:40am. We start giving the guidelines from 8:50am. (School opens from 8:00am)
- ② Those who are late by 20 minutes or more after the examination starts, cannot take the examination.
- ③ There will be a sticker with your examination number on the desk. Please check your examination number and take the seat of your number.
- ④ The interview time will be confirmed with the materials distributed at the reception on the day of the examination. We are not able to inform you of your interview time before the examination day.

(3) About Lunch

- ① Depending on the time of your interview, you may need to bring a lunch.
- ② While waiting to complete their interview, applicants will be allowed to have lunch in the examination room, so please make sure to bring a portable lunch box by yourself, as you will not be in contact with your parent or guardian.

(4) Guidelines for Parents

- ① Please use public transportation to come to our school. The parking lot located in the school or at nearby facilities like the botanical gardens are not available.
- ② There are parent waiting rooms on the examination day, so please wait there during the examination.
- ③ The parent or guardian of prospective students who are to be interviewed should move to the interview room 10 minutes before the interview starts.
- ④ The Cafeteria in our school is closed.

9. Announcement of Successful Applicants and Admission Procedures

(2) Admission Procedures

(2-1) Distribution of Documents

We will send the Letter of Acceptance by express delivery before the end of the business day on the day of announcement. Read the enclosed *Admission Procedures Booklet* carefully and complete the admission procedures within the prescribed period (listed below).

<Admission procedure period>

• November Examination:

First step (payment of admission fee): December 2 (Fri.) to December 16 (Fri.), 2022

Second step (submission of documents): February 13 (Mon.) to February 17 (Fri.), 2023

• February Examination:

Payment of admission fee and submission of documents:

February 13 (Mon.) to February 17 (Fri.), 2023

* As a rule, the admission fee is non-refundable. For example, if a successful applicant is unable to secure a student visa to study in Japan, the admission fee will not be refunded.

(2-2) Visa Application Procedures (optional)

1. Ritsumeikan Uji sends the application form for the Certificate of Eligibility to the applicant.



2. The applicant fills in the form and returns it to us.



3. Ritsumeikan Uji submits the form to the Osaka Immigration Office.



4. The Osaka Immigration Office issues the Certificate of Eligibility.



5. Ritsumeikan Uji sends the applicant the Certificate of Eligibility.



6. The applicant submits the Certificate of Eligibility to the Japanese embassy and obtains a visa.

* Non-Japanese nationals currently living overseas will need a visa in order to study at Ritsumeikan Uji. This requirement is not mandatory for students already living in Japan.

* If the applicant is not able to obtain a visa issued by a Japanese embassy or does not complete the procedures within the prescribed period, the applicant will lose the right of admission.

* Tuition fees for the 2023 academic year have not been decided. We revise school fees every year and will inform applicants of the updated fees at the time of the announcement of successful applicants.

* Required additional fees like school uniforms and textbooks, reserve funds for study trips, and membership fees for intramural associations are not included in the figures above.

10. Scholarship System

An applicant **who takes the November Examination (including at school and the online November examination) in the “Recommendation category”** can apply for the Incentive Scholarship Program. This program offers a stipend to selected students who have an excellent command of a foreign language or excellent academic ability in science and mathematics, and who show remarkable scholastic achievement.

(1) Outline of the Scholarship System

- Amount

Scholarship students receive a stipend of 500,000 yen per year. We examine the academic record of scholarship students every year.

- Number of Scholarship Students

18 (to be selected from among all applicants, including those from other courses.)

(2) Scholarship Application Procedure

- Qualification

An applicant must take the November entrance examination in the **Recommendation category**.

- Documents to be submitted

a. Application form

b. Self-recommendation letter

* Download the above form from our website.

- Period

October 24 (Mon.) to November 7 (Mon.), 2022

Enclose the scholarship application with the entrance examination application and send both applications together to the school during the application period. The application documents must arrive no later than November 7.

- Method of Selection

After the receipt of documents, interviews for applicants who passed the documents screening will be held on December 24 (Sat.). (Interviews will be conducted online for applicants residing overseas and at the school for applicants residing in Japan.)

- Delivery of results

• The results of the document screening will be mailed to the applicant on December 2(Fri.). (It will be enclosed with the notification of acceptance)

• The results of the interview will be mailed to the applicant on or after December 26 (Mon.).

11. Dormitory

As a rule, all international students who are not staying with a parent or guardian in Japan must live in the dormitory.

192 (111 for male students; 81 for female students)

(8) Capacity:

384 (222 male students and 162 female students)

(9) Board and Lodging Charges:

(The information below is for the 2022 academic year.)

Dormitory Admission Fee: 150,000 yen

Boarding Fee: 480,000 yen (per year)

Food Expenses: 1,274 yen (per day, for two meals)

* Residents must pay a membership fee for the boarding student association (3,400 yen) in addition to the above fees.

* The full costs of the dormitory admission fee, boarding fee, and meal expenses for the 2023 academic year have not been decided. We revise these fees every year and will inform successful applicants of the 2023 fees at the time of the announcement of results.

* The dormitory is closed for several days during long-term vacations.

* Dormitory meals cannot be guaranteed to be allergen-free.

12. Application Instructions

(1) Application Form (printed out from application web system)

(1-1) After web registration, you can print out the Application Form from application web system.

(2) Personal Information Form (attached to this booklet)

(2-1) Circle the items in the box using thick lines.

(2-2) Write your nationality (if an international student).

(2-3) Write the full name of a parent or guardian in the box labeled “Guardian.”

(2-4) The emergency contact number of the guardian must be a number at which we can contact them directly and promptly during the application procedures.

(2-5) Fill out the section about your educational background on the reverse side, referring to page 18. Write the city and the country where your schools are located. Include your entire school career.

(2-6) English Proficiency (required for all applicants)

Fill in the results of an examination of English proficiency (EIKEN, TOEFL iBT[®] Test, TOEFL Junior[®] Test, TOEIC[®] Test, Cambridge ESOL, IELTS are acceptable). Attach a copy of the qualification certificate. If you plan to submit the result of an English proficiency examination other than those listed above, please contact us.

(2-7) If you have a certification, license or special ability, or have accomplished a remarkable achievement, write it in the box marked “Special Ability etc.” Please attach a copy of each certificate or license.

(2-8) If you would like to add any additional information, include it in the box marked “Notes.”

(2-9) All international students must live in the dormitory or with a parent or guardian. We do not permit any students to live by themselves (e.g., in an apartment or hotel).

(3) Supplementary Information Form (attached to this booklet)

(3-1) A parent or guardian must complete these documents.

(3-2) Complete all required information in as much detail as possible. If there is not enough space, use another piece of paper and attach copies of relevant documents.

(3-3) Include the name of the subject and its contents, if any, to Question 2.

(3-4) Explain the evaluation method in Question 3.

(3-5) Describe any volunteer or other significant activities that the applicant has taken part in, whether as an individual or in a group/organization. If a group activity, write the name of the group and the applicant’s role within it.

(3-6) Send a sealed transcript for your last three years of school. If you need to open the transcript in order to check some information you may; however, in this case send the original envelope that the transcript came in along with the transcript itself.

(4) Recommendation Form (attached to this booklet)

As a rule, to take the exam under the Recommendation category, the applicant must get a recommendation from the principal of the school they attend, and submit the designated recommendation form when sending the application documents.

(5) Reason for Selecting IB Course (attached to this booklet)

Use black ink to fill out the form in English.

(6) Certificate of School Attendance (must be the original certificate with the signature of the principal, not a photocopy)

Submit a document certifying that you have attended an overseas educational institution for a period that satisfies the qualification for application. You do not have to submit this document if you submit the transcript below. This document must include the actual signature of the principal.

(7) Transcripts (must be the original certificate with the signature of the principal, not a photocopy)


Submit your academic record for the three years corresponding to the Japanese junior high school curriculum (grades 7-9 in a standard western school system). If you have already completed this curriculum, submit also any academic record completed thereafter. If you transferred schools at any point during the past three years, send records from all schools attended.

(8) IB Course Applicant Reference Form (attached to this booklet)

All IB Course applicants must submit the IB Course Applicant Reference Form. If possible, it should be completed by a teacher who knows the student well and can write in detail about the student. Otherwise, another teacher, school counselor, or school administrator may complete the form. The Reference Form must be submitted in the sealed envelope along with all of the other required application documents.

(9) Envelope for Application Documents

The envelope should look similar to the example shown below. There is no mandated format; however, the following example will ensure swift processing.

If an applicant is in the tenth-grade or higher at an educational institution in the country of residence, but is under 16 years old as of April 1, 2023, please consult the school individually.

* Refer to pages 1 through 11 of this booklet for other information.

We offer transfer students an orientation. The details of this will be provided on the day that successful applicants are announced.

* A ninth-grade curriculum is equivalent to the third-year curriculum at a junior high school in Japan. If an applicant has completed a nine-year curriculum at an institution outside Japan, but is younger than 15 years old as of April 1, 2023, please consult the school individually.

* An applicant who takes the entrance examination for the 2023 academic year cannot apply to take a transfer examination during the same academic year.




